YOUNG RESEARCH FORUM

We welcome all the young researchers and students to present your study in the Poster Competition. If an abstract is accepted, authors must attend the meeting and present it in person. Abstracts are to be presented as a poster. The size of the poster should be 90 x 120 cm. All accepted abstracts will be printed in the meeting abstract book.

Preferred size: A1 (if resubmitting a poster from a previous event please state poster size on abstract submission) Poster can be resubmitted from another conference (within the last 18 months) One or more of the authors(s) will be expected to attend the conference Details regarding displaying the poster at the conference will be given nearer the time


